



### Loving

Show understanding of how religious belief in God's unconditional love shapes life and engage with and respond to questions about loving in the light of religious teaching.

### Vocation and commitment

Show an understanding of how religious belief shapes lives of Christians in a variety of ways through their chosen vocation and engage with and respond to questions of life in the light of religious teaching.

### Expectations

Describe and show understanding of religious sources, beliefs, ideas, feelings and experiences of Advent as a time of joyful expectation of Christmas, making links between them and show understanding of how religious belief in Advent as a time of joyful expectation shapes lives.

### Sources

Show how their own and others' decisions are informed by beliefs and values which may be influenced by what they have read and describe and show understanding of the Bible, the beliefs, ideas, feelings and experiences of the Christian and make links between them.

### Unity

Use religious terms to show an understanding of different aspect of the Eucharist and show understanding of how belief in the uniting presence of Jesus Christ in Holy Communion shapes the lives of Christians.

### Death and new life

Use religious terms to show an understanding of the different liturgies of Ash Wednesday Lent, Friday of the Passion of the Lord, and The Easter Vigil in the Holy Night and show understanding of how religious belief in death and new life shapes life

### Witnesses

Describe and show understanding of Scripture, beliefs, ideas, feelings and experiences of the power of the Holy Spirit in witnessing to the Good News of Jesus Christ, and make links between them. Engage with and respond to questions concerning the courage it takes to witness to the Good News of Jesus Christ

### Healing

Show how their own and others' decisions about care and compassion towards the sick are informed by beliefs and values and describe and show understanding of religious sources, beliefs, ideas, feelings and experiences concerning the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick, and make links between them. Use religious terms to show an understanding of the different liturgies which the sacraments offer to the sick and dying and show understanding of how religious belief shapes life, and that caring for those in need is a Christian responsibility.

### Common good

Show understanding of how religious belief in justice and of the common good of all shapes life and engage with and respond to big questions around justice and the common good in the light of religious teaching.
